February is a bonus borrow month-Every quarter, hoopla allows an unlimited amount of checkouts on a set amount of titles that do not count against your monthly allotment .

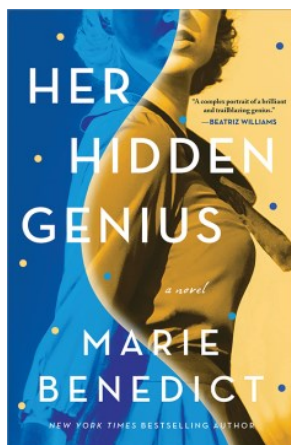

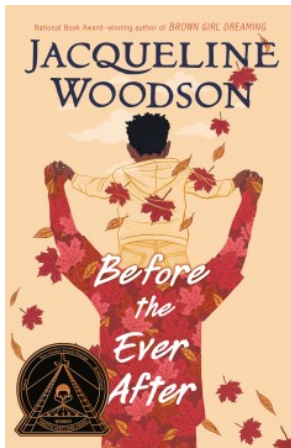
## STAFF PICKS/NEW BOOKS

by Jacqueline Woodson

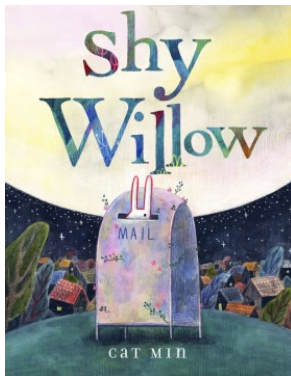

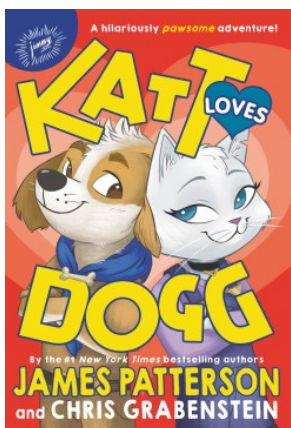
When a mustachioed rabbit spots a mustache contest, he is met with some serious facial hair competition.

by Cat Min

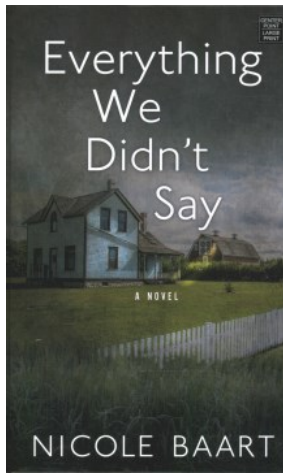

by James Patterson

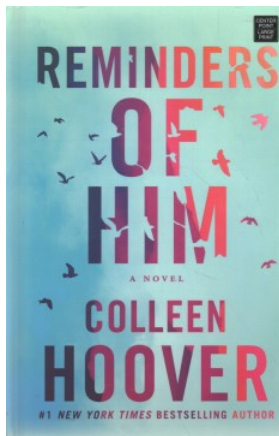

by Nicole Baart

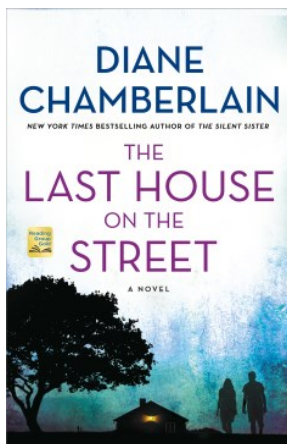

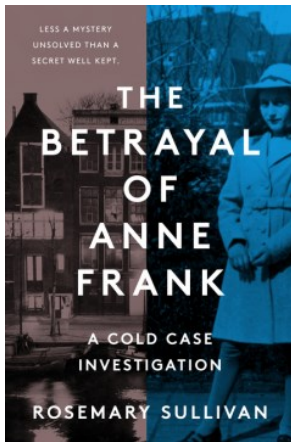

by Diane Chamberlain

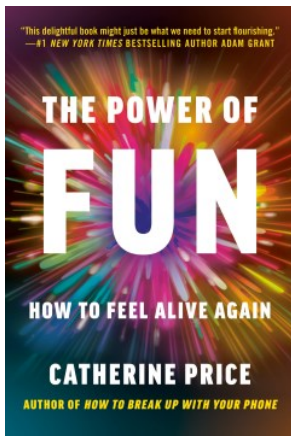

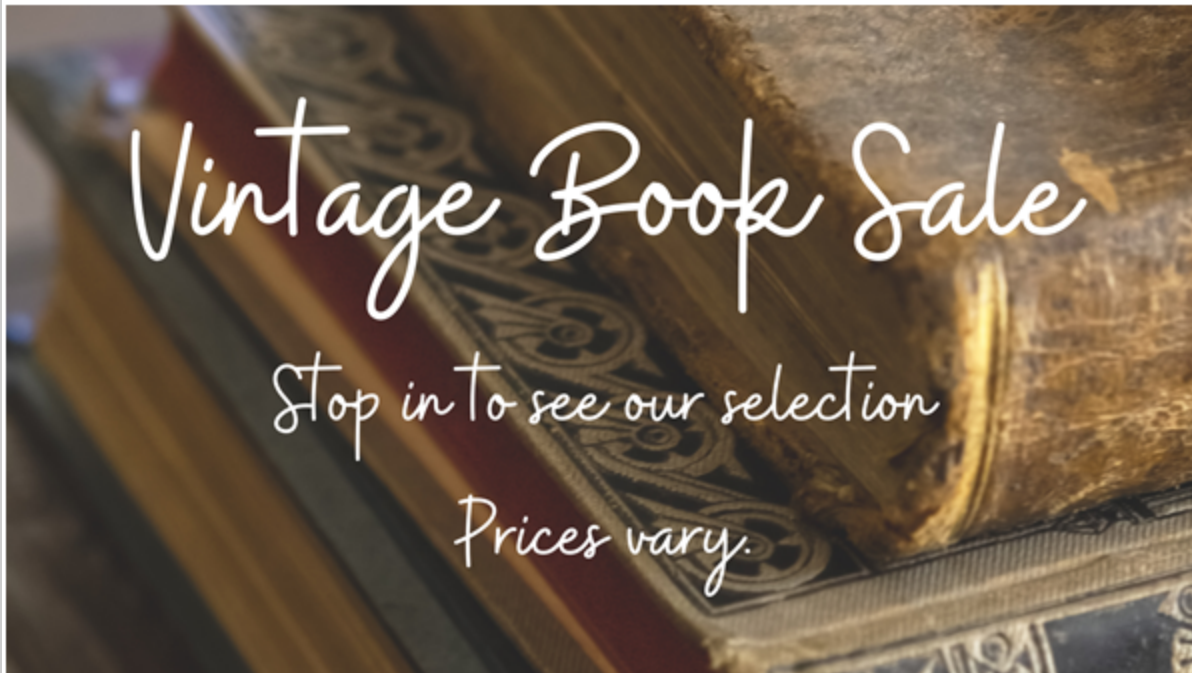
