We would like to give a big thank you to Bob Copperstone for his generous donation of the Lincoln Journal Star.

Bob wanted everyone to know the reasons for this donation. “While visiting the Wahoo Public Library recently, I wondered why a copy of one of the state’s two metro daily newspapers-the Lincoln Journal Star-was missing. I put the question to Library Director Denise Lawver. ‘Strained budgets, she explained, along with necessary reprioritizing based on readership figures’. Newspaper subscription costs have soared out of reach for many people (and their libraries) nationwide. The yearly daily subscriptions here cost \$500-\$700 or more. Denise tried to get a lower rate for our library, but none was offered.

It’s a good cause and helps keep the printed work in the public eye.”

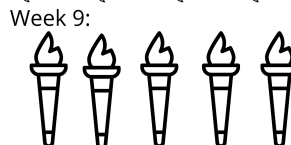

Our FREE early childhood education program partners with children, families, and the community to build the skills children need to be successful in school and in life. Our comprehensive program serves the whole family.


- Supporting families with children from 3-5 years old

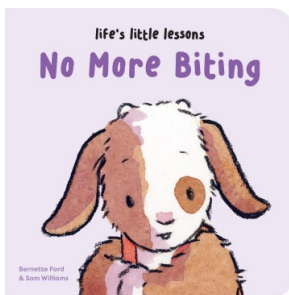
## [Lost birds](#)

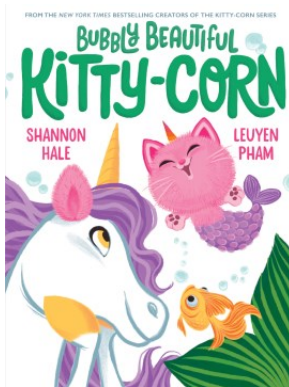

by Bernette Ford

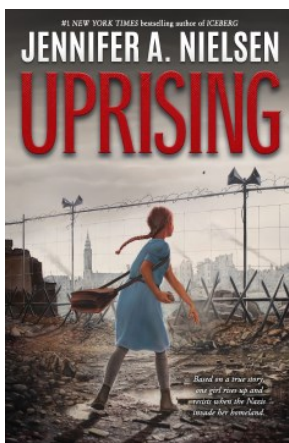

by Shannon Hale

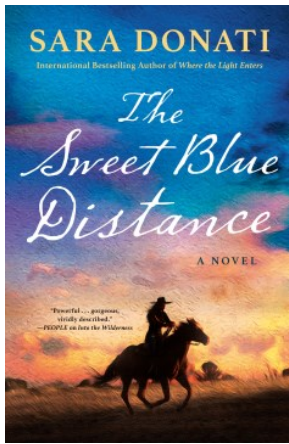

by Jennifer A. Nielsen

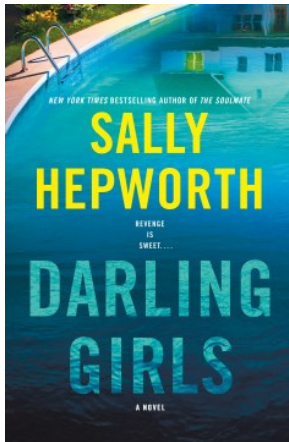
