LIBRARY CARD FEES

THIS MONTH WE WOULD LIKE TO GIVE YOU ALL A SHORT EXPLANATION ABOUT THE CHARGE FOR A WAHOO LIBRARY CARD IF YOU DO NOT RESIDE IN THE CITY LIMITS.

THE WAHOO PUBLIC LIBRARY IS FUNDED THROUGH PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS FROM CITIZENS/PROPERTY OWNERS WHO RESIDE IN THE CITY LIMITS OF WAHOO. THE LIBRARY DOES NOT RECEIVE ANY OTHER TAX SUPPORT FROM SAUNDERS COUNTY NOR DO THE OTHER FIVE LIBRARIES LOCATED IN THE COUNTY.

IN FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 A HOMEOWNER IN WAHOO PAID \$10.87 PER MONTH BASED ON A SINGLE-FAMILY HOME VALUED AT \$200,000 FOR LIBRARY SERVICES. SAUNDERS COUNTY RESIDENTS WHO PURCHASED A CARD PAID \$20 FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR, AN ADDITIONAL CARD IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD IS JUST \$1.00.

WE BEGAN CHARGING FOR THE LIBRARY CARDS BACK IN THE 1990'S AT THE SUGGESTION OF A THEN COUNTY SUPERVISOR, ALL OF THE LIBRARIES MADE A YEARLY REQUEST FOR FUNDING FROM THE COUNTY AND FOR SEVERAL YEARS WE ALL RECEIVED A SMALL STIPEND PAID FROM THE INHERITANCE TAX FUND. WHEN A FINANCIAL SHORTFALL OCCURRED A FEW YEARS AGO ALL OF THE FUNDING TO THE COUNTY LIBRARIES ENDED. WE HAVE CHARGED \$20 PER YEAR FOR THE CARDS SINCE 2006. IN THIS DAY AND AGE OF INFLATION I THINK THAT COST IS AN AWESOME BARGAIN, I KNOW MY PROPERTY TAXES HAVEN'T STAYED THE SAME SINCE 2006!

IF A RESIDENT OF SAUNDERS COUNTY SHOWS US THAT THEY OWN PROPERTY IN THE CITY LIMITS OF WAHOO THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR THE CARD.

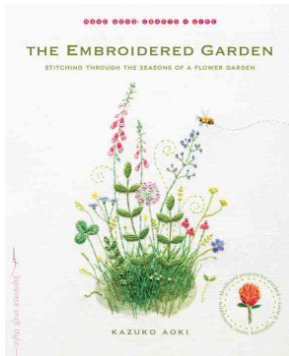

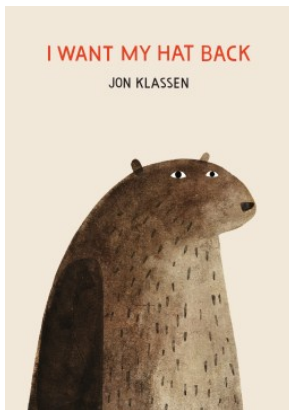
The Embroidered Garden: Stitching Through the Seasons of a Flower Garden

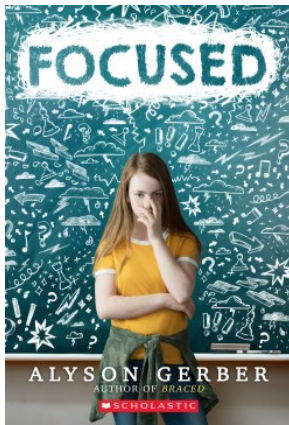

by Kate Alice Marshall

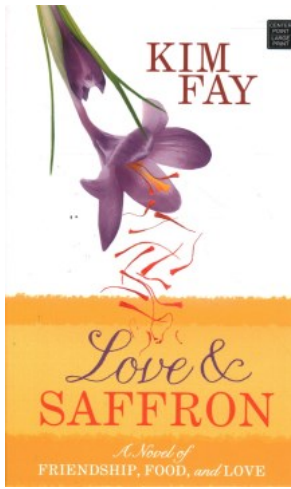

by Melissa Fu

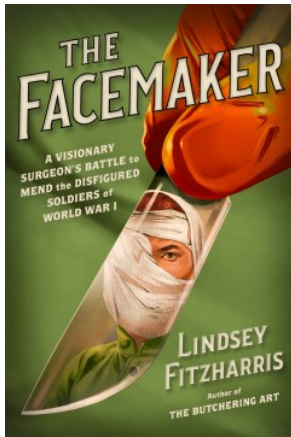

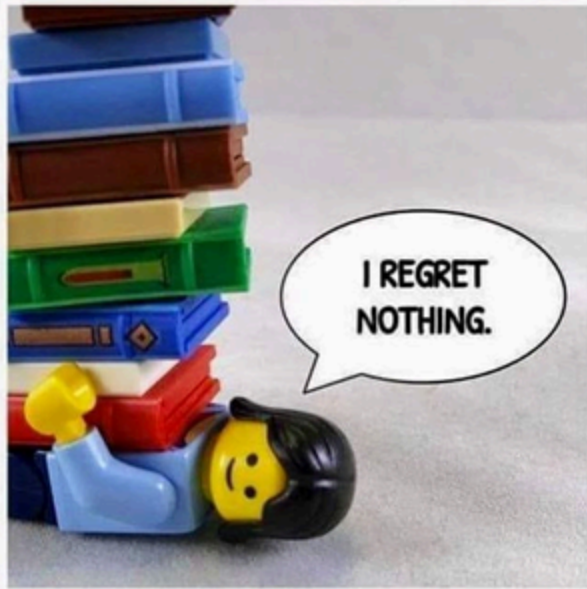


The Facemaker: A Visionary Surgeon's Battle to Mend the Disfigured Soldiers of World War I
